Notification of Parent/Guardian Prior to Postural Screening

During the month of **March 2016**, a postural screening program to detect possible curvatures of the spine will be conducted for all students in **Grade 5**. The screening will take place at the school by a school nurse during PE class. The purpose of this program is to recognize the signs of spinal curvature at its earliest stages so that the need for treatment can be determined.

The screening process consists of a visual examination of your child's back. The procedure for the examination is a simple one that requires less than one minute. The trained nurse inspects your child's spine as he/she stands and then bends forward. If a spinal problem is suspected, your child will be rechecked at a second screening.

A separate notice will be sent home with your child to notify you at which PE class the screening will take place and give further instructions.

If you have any questions concerning the postural screening, or **do not wish your child to participate in the postural screening program**, please contact the Health Office.


