I look forward to seeing you at these upcoming events.



## PARENT PORTAL IS NOW OPENIU

The Bethel Public School District uses PowerSchool, an internet based student management information system. This information system includes a a section known as the parent portal which will give parents the ability to access important information about their child(ren) over the internet in a secure manner.

This information is critical to providing us the most accurate information and phone numbers if there was an emergency. If during the school year any of your demographic information were to change, you can update it at any point. You no longer need to call the school. The school secretary will receive an email indicating you have made a change. In this form you will also be asked to sign off on district forms, which will now all be housed electronically. In addition, you will have access to your child's attendance record as well as report cards. We recognize that some families do not have a computer at home or do not have internet access. If this is the case, please feel free to visit our local library where computers with internet access are available for use. 


