On Wednesday, we celebrated our Johnson Pride Students of the Month at an assembly. I would like to take this opportunity to address a few questions.

#### Q. Will I be able to access my child's report card if I did not update my forms on the Parent Portal?

A. No. In an effort to "go green" this year, no paper report cards will be distributed. It is imperative that you update all information on the Parent Portal to be able to access your child's report card. Report cards will be available on December 9, 2016.

#### Q. How do I access my child's report card on the Parent Portal?

- A. To access your child's report card, please follow the steps below:
- Log into the Parent Portal
- If you have more than one child, click on your child's name at the top left corner
- Click "Grades and Attendance" on the left hand column
- Click the "Standard Grades" tab on top. Current classes will appear.
- Click "Expand All" located at the top right.
- The trimester comment from the classroom teacher will appear at the bottom, under "BPS.COMMENTS.ooi Trimester i – Comment". You must click on the comment icon box to see the comment
- If there is a specialist comment, you should see a comment icon box that you can click on next to the standard. *Please note: Not all students will have specialist comments.*

#### Q. Why can't we share lockdown procedures on Facebook?

A. Student safety is a priority at all of our schools. As a practice, we do not share our safety protocols on social media to ensure confidentiality. This is *critical* as we do not ever want this information to go out publicly which can pose a potential safety risk. If you have any questions, please contact the school directly.

#### Q. Can students bring Pokemon cards to school?

A. Students may bring them to school for before school, recess, or after school use. However, if it becomes an issue, or if it interferes with instruction in the classroom, the teacher may request that your child leaves the cards at home.

Johnson School is working diligently to ensure that parents have a clear understanding of how students are assessed. We have assembled a holiday display case for the students to help decorate. Children will receive a paper snowflake for donating a toy. We will write their name on the snowflake and add it to our display case.


The display case and collection box are located in the front foyer. There will be parent volunteers present to assist the children during collection times.
