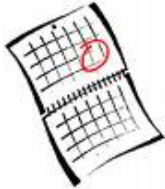
LATE FEE

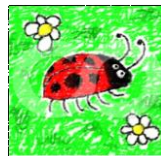

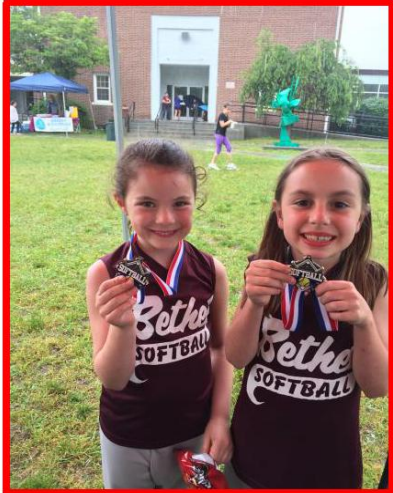
