Dear Parents, Guardians and Caregivers,

In May all Johnson School students will be taking the Smarter Balanced Assessment in mathematics and English language arts/literacy. Fifth grade students will be taking the Next Generation Science pilot test at the end of April. This is the state mandated test that replaces the Connecticut Mastery Test (CMT) in those areas. The assessment will be taken on a computer and will be untimed. Students will work at their own pace to complete each segment of the assessment.

We will begin administering the Smarter Balanced Assessment on Tuesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>. Students will test in a one hour window and attend regular classes for the rest of the day. We hope to have all testing completed by May 11<sup>th</sup>. Make-ups for students who are absent will occur as soon as students return.

Prior to testing students will be given an opportunity to view the practice test and the training test. If you would like to view this test with your son or daughter you may access the practice test at <a href="http://ct.portal.airast.org/training-tests/">http://ct.portal.airast.org/training-tests/</a>.

Both schools and parents will receive information about individual student performance. We use the Smarter Balanced Assessment, as well as other measures, to improve programming for students. It is very important that each of our students gives his/her best effort and truly demonstrates his/her ability.

On the days we are testing we urge you to have students to school on time, well rested, and ready to participate. While students will be testing on a computer, there is no other technology allowed in the testing rooms. Please remind your son or daughter to leave phones and iPods stored in their backpacks during testing.
